To facilitate the integration of international students, we propose them a double/triple room accommodation.



B. Educational project

In the Halls of Residence the learning path is developed through a continuous dialogue that begins with **tutoring** in the first university year, goes further with **coaching** and **placement** guiding towards the job market. This educational model is typical of Rui's Halls of Residence and is designed to fulfill students' needs through **a tailored and flexible program for competences' development**.

The program JUMP Job-University Matching Project (jump.rui.it) is a modular learning path including: soft skills development, interdisciplinary courses, professional activities targeted to specific study fields aiming at developing the competences requested by the job market. Thanks to international agreements, the program is developed in a multicultural environment.







2. Entrance requirements

All **Italian and international students** can enter Rui's Halls if they are enrolling for the academic year 2024/25 in every kind of University or Higher Education Institution and if:

- they passed the secondary school-leaving examination;
- they can provide documents about the attended university course with exams' list, grades and credits;
- they can provide the final qualification for first/second cycle university course;
- they have filled in the application form and passed the admission test, as indicated in the following point 3 of this call.

3. Application

The admission process has the following phases:

- A. filling in the on-line application form on MyCollege (mycollege.fondazionerui.it);
- B. admission test at the chosen Hall (or on-line if agreed by the board of Directors);
- C. confirming the place;
- D. signing the contract.



A. On-line application

The on-line application for Rui's Halls of Residence must be completed after signing up on **MyCollege platform** (<u>mycollege.fondazionerui.it</u>). The application form has different sessions; it is mandatory to complete the entire form with **personal data and curricular information**, uploading the following documents:

- students who are enrolling in the first university year:
 - curriculum vitae;
 - school reports of the last three years of secondary school;
 - certificate of secondary school-leaving examination (if the application form is filled in before the examination, you can upload the certificate later); you should demonstrate to have been attending a secondary school for at least 12 years;
 - other certification about extra curricular activities (facultative);
 - students who are attending a university course:
 - curriculum vitae;
 - the final qualification for first cycle university course (if applicable) or in alternative a certificate proving the completion of one or two years of academic studies or post secondary qualification;
 - a certificate with the planned exams and the passed exams with grades and credits;
 - other certification about extra curricular activities (facultative).



To be admitted to the admission test it is mandatory to fill in the **questionnaire** as well: through it the candidate presents himself/herself to the board of directors of the Hall of Residence. Uploading a video self presentation is available too.

Every other document (language knowledge, sport, volunteering certifications, motivational letter, etc.) will be examined to integrate and support the application.

The board of directors will examine the application and will admit or not the candidate to the following step, the admission test. So, the candidate must wait for a confirmation by email before going to the Hall of Residence for the admission test on the expected day.

B. Admission test

The admission test consists of interviews and presentations of the hall of residence's educational program, to understand the candidate's motivation in participating and playing an active role in the Hall's life. In some halls of residence tests, group dynamics and written exams are previewed. The admission test for international students can be done by videoconference as well. It's recommended to book as soon as possible the admission test, to have more admission opportunities.

The admission process is merit based but depends on the availability of places as well. The result of the admission test is communicated by email. The result of the admission test is based on the following items: academic merit, accuracy and completeness of the application form, acceptance of the educational agreement, soft skills.

C. Confirming the place

Students that remain in the Hall of Residence for at least an academic year need to pay an enrollment fee of \in 1.000.00 to confirm the place after passing the admission test and receiving the related communication. The enrollment fee should be paid by the deadline indicated in the email received after the admission. If the candidate doesn't pay the enrollment fee by the deadline, the place will be given to another student. In case the candidate renounces the place the paid enrollment fee will not be returned.

Students that remain in the Hall of Residence less than a year need to pay \in 1000.00 to confirm the place. This payment will be considered as an advance on the Hall of Residence fee. The payment should be done by the deadline indicated in the email received after the admission. If the candidate doesn't pay the \in 1000,00 by the deadline, the place will be given to another student. In case the candidate renounces the place the \in 1000.00 will not be returned.

D. Signing the contract

The stay of admitted students in a Hall of Residence is regulated by a contract. The following data are needed to complete the contract:

- resident personal data;
- a guarantor personal data (i.e. mother, father etc.).

These data should be filled in on <u>MyCollege</u>. The contract must be signed to complete the admission process; it is valid for one academic year and must be renovated each following year.



4. Fees and financial aids

The Hall of Residence fee covers one year (from September 1st to July 31st) except some specific situations, i.e. the Erasmus students who stay for a shorter time. The annual fee depends on the services provided by each Hall of Residence, as described at <u>www.rui.it</u>.

Special rates are available for all international students: annual fees, balanced to the real months of stay, are **reduced up to 40%**, depending on geographical origin of the international students and the living cost of the destination.

(*) Torriana offers two types of accommodation: the apartments (single or double room) with two meals per week or the main building (single room only) with full board and laundry.

(**) For stays of less than 6 months, a fee equal to 50% of the annual discounted fee is applied; exceptions can only be granted by the Residence Management. Besides this, we inform you that, given the full fee and the discount percentage, the subsidized amount is rounded to the nearest multiple of \in 50.

International students can apply for **further financial aids according to their family income** and for **merit based scholarships**, as described below.

C. Seniorship

Rui Foundation may grant an additional **4% seniorship discount on the full fee to international residents from their 3rd year of residence** on. This discount will be assigned on the basis of the following criteria: years of stay, merit regards the sharing of the educational program, academic merit and active participation in Residence life. The



seniorship discount will be assigned in accordance with the unquestionable decision of the Residence Direction Team and until the exhaustion of funds. The seniorship discount will be active from the academic year 2026/27.

D. Your free year

A competition for all the admitted students: the best one will be awarded 1 place completely for free; other 2 outstanding students will be awarded 2 places at 50% of discount. <u>Download the call for this competition by visiting www.rui.it</u>.

E. GRANTalento

Among the admitted students in each of our halls, the most talented ones can apply for a further discount up to 1.000€ on the annual fee.

F. Other aids

Two or more siblings, who are all admitted in our halls, can apply for a further 1.000 \in discount each.
